

### Frequently Asked Questions

- When does the fee for charging my vehicle take effect?
  - January 1st, 2024
- How long can I charge my vehicle?
  - Maximum of 4 hours.
- How much will it cost to charge my vehicle?
  - \$2 per hour for SCU constituents.
  - \$3 per hour for non-SCU constituents.
- Can I park my vehicle at an electric vehicle charging space (EVCS) without charging?
  - No, you may not park a vehicle in an EVCS without actively charging unless you are in a shared ADA & EVCS space. If so, a DMV-issued ADA placard is required to park in a shared ADA/EVCS without actively charging.
- What happens if I am late to move my car after charging is complete?
  - Vehicle owners have a 30-minute grace period to move vehicles.
  - After the 30-minute grace period has expired, overtime fees will commence.
- Can I charge my vehicle without a parking permit?
  - No, a valid SCU permit (decal/hangtag/pay and display) is required to park and charge at a ChargePoint station.
